Average progress from the end of KS1 to the end of KS2 for all pupils nationally is given a score of 0; better or worse progress than this is shown with either a positive or negative progress score. To account for the natural uncertainty in a population of pupils 95% confidence intervals around progress scores are provided as a proxy for the range of scores within which each school's underlying performance can be confidently said to lie.
